

Apply to Join the DAA Board

The Dalhousie Alumni Association (DAA) Board is currently seeking applications from Dalhousie University alumni interested in joining the DAA Board as new board members from September 2023.

The DAA Board is an approximately 17-person advisory board that supports the university's senior administrative team by advising on issues of alumni engagement. The Board's membership seeks to broadly represent Dalhousie's faculties, as well as the geographic regions and graduation years of its alumni community. The Dalhousie alumni community comprises 156,000+ individuals located around the globe. We welcome applications for board positions from across the community and, this year, we are particularly interested in applications from individuals with experience in:

- Governance / Advisory Board Experience / Committee Experience
- Customer Relations / Employee Engagement
- Strategy and Advisory Services
- Marketing / Communications / Events and Programming / Fundraising

Equally, we are particularly interested in applications from individuals with experience relating to the following faculties:

- Arts and Social Sciences
- Science
- Architecture and Planning
- Computer Science
- Dentistry
- Health Professions

We welcome applications from Dalhousie alumni around the world. To reflect the distribution of our current alumni community, we particularly encourage applications from individuals based in the following regions:

- Western Canada
- India
- China

Further, alumni from any graduating year are eligible to apply for a board member position. To reflect the distribution of the current alumni community, the DAA Board is particularly hoping to improve the representation of recent graduates (i.e. those individuals that have graduated within the last five years) in its board membership.

Finally, in line with Dalhousie's commitment to diversity and inclusion, we encourage applicants from underrepresented groups, including but not limited to the Indigenous, African-Nova Scotian, and LGBTQ2SIA+ populations.

Your application should set out your motivation for applying for a DAA Board position, your relevant skills and experience (including any past board-level experience), as well as your relevant background. Please be sure to include your name, address, grad year, and faculty (or faculties) from which you graduated.

All applications will be forwarded to the DAA Nominating Committee, who will follow up with applicants after the application period closes. The appointment of new board members will take place during the DAA Board's Annual General Meeting in May 2023.
